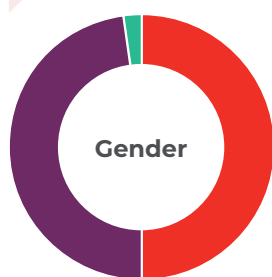
Creating work connections: supporting people to live great lives.

Workwise supports people facing personal or health challenges to find and keep a job.

Our integrated approach means employment support is provided much earlier in a person's recovery, is coordinated with healthcare, and clinical treatment is tailored to support a person's working life. In tightened economic circumstances and a tougher labour market, we know that employment support has a positive impact on people securing work and other opportunities.

We value our relationships with Te Whatu Ora and housing support organisations LinkPeople and The People's Project, and the knowledge that together, we're making a difference.

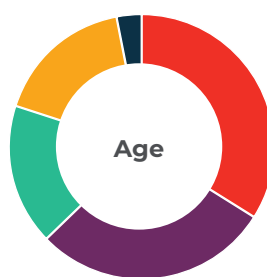
This year, we worked with **212 new people** - helping them to find work and to stay in work.
